

Landscape Report

May 21, 2009

1. Bark the pool area. A bid has been submitted from Heather Farms Landscape.
2. Remove the dead tree from the hillside in the lawn area of the pool.
3. Prune the dead branches in the plum tree next to the dead tree.
4. Remove dead tree on the corner of Whitecliff Way and Robb Rd.

What is included in the Landscape budget-any plantings in the landscaped areas of the Homeowners' Association. This does not include tree removal. The Landscape Committee may recommend that the Board remove dead or dying trees but tree removal is a separate line item in the budget.

The Landscape Committee has been asked to submit long range plans for our planted areas. We hope to maintain the plantings we have but some of our areas have old plants and require more water. The area the committee is considering changing is along Rudgear Rd. between Whitecliff Way and Kristen. There are trees under stress because the pittosporum impedes good watering. We would like to eliminate all the pittosporum, zylasma and trees replacing this strip with a drip system, Chinese Pistache trees and bark. We have presented this plan to the Board in past years and have had no action.
